## Flamand Continues Hot Streak with 2<sup>nd</sup> Win of 2011

Greg Flamand won his second tournament of 2011 and third of his career with a 237-195 final match victory over champion Jeff Voght. Flamand bowled 202, 213 & 205 on the Saturday night squad then switched balls to finish with 289 & 257. Even though his score may have made it off the at-large list, he came back for the Sunday morning squad. He earned himself a guaranteed spot in match play by leading the squad with 248, 239, 258, 289 & 246 for 1280. After a one round bye, the right-hander averaged 240.2 with wins over a few champions and two new young members. Flamand won \$1,550 plus another white shirt & trophy. His win increased his lead on the points list to 86 points, which is a huge led halfway through the season. Flamand also has the highest block of the season (1315), has made the cut at each tournament he entered and is second in average.

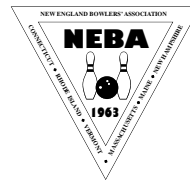
Jeff Voght made the three hour drive from Canajoharie, NY for the last qualifying squad. He put together games of 228, 208, 267, 256 & 278 for second on the squad with 1237. Voght followed a one round bye with some big games en route the championship match. He got behind early then a split in the 6<sup>th</sup> frame left him with a 33 pin deficit. The 2-time champion won \$850 for his runner-up finish

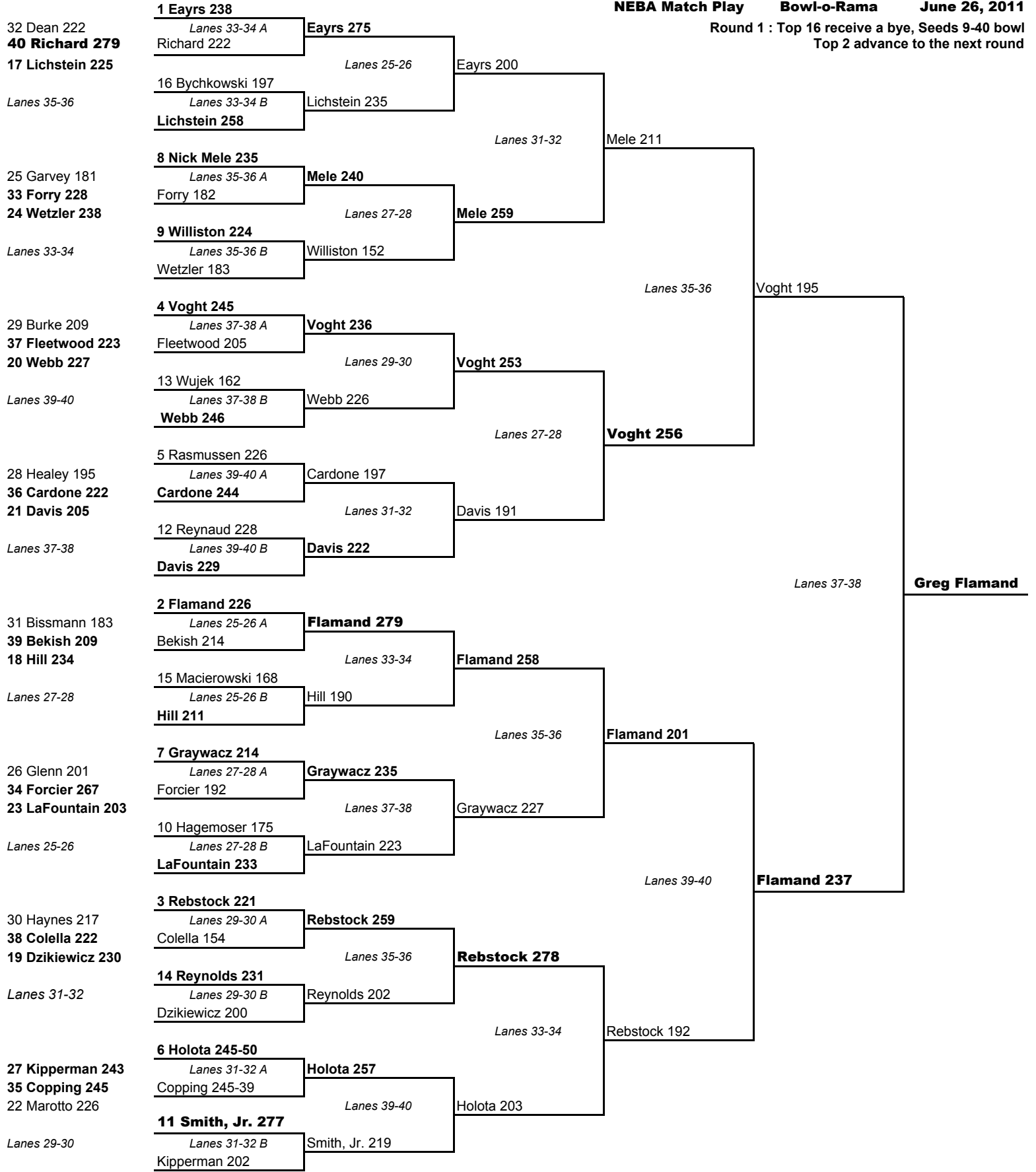
