REYNAUD STRIKES AGAIN – WINS 2ND TITLE OF THE YEAR AT THE BOWL-O-RAMA

TONY REYNAUD from Harwinton, CT won his second title of 2009 with a narrow 215-204 victory over John Bedard at Newington Bowl-O-Rama. This is his seventh career win since his first in 1983 at 21 years old. Reynaud is also a two-time bowler of the year. In Newington, the righty shot 1201 on the Saturday night squad with games of 268, 235, 248, 212 and 238 which was good enough to advance him off the top of the at-large list. After a one round bye, he defeated champions George Tignor (Winchendon, MA) 196-187, Jon Matunas (Newington, CT) 267-233, Dave Forcier (Coventry, RI) 266-232 and Chris Viale (Westfield, MA) 201-189 on way to the championship match. The experienced Reynaud took early control in the final match; creating a 22 pin lead by the seventh frame. Back-to-back single pin spare misses the next two frames, let Bedard in the match. Bedard was working on a strike but left a seven pin then followed it with a strike in the ninth. Reynaud finished first with a clutch triple in the tenth which forced Bedard to double in the tenth. A six pin stood in the way of Bedard's first win. Reynaud won \$1,250 while averaging 234.6 for the day. He has advanced to match play in 4 of the 5 tournaments he entered. His latest win moved him into second on the points and average lists.

JOHN BEDARD from Bridgeport, CT advanced to match play by making the 12:30 squad cut with games of 256, 223, 191, 237 and 230 for 1137. In the first round, the 39 year-old shot 212 against George Tignor's 218 and 189 by Mike Centrone to advance to round two. He knocked out #2 seed Eric Copping (Websterville, NH) 225-201 and non-member Craig Kleinman 189-187 then champions Tom Andrelli (Groton, CT) 233-170 and Scott Santos (Ledyard, CT) 234-168. After bowling a few tournaments a year, Bedard found himself in his first championship match since he started competing in NEBA back in 2001. He showed no nerves by making quality shots which hit the pocket frame after frame yet only struck half the time. This is Bedard is two for two in match play appearances in 2009. The lefty averaged 221.2 for his eleven games in Newington and won \$725 for his runner-up finish.

There were 169 entries at Bowl-O-Rama which advanced forty bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1151. Squad cuts were 1214 on Saturday night (squad leader **Jon Matunas** with 1338), 1182 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Eric Copping** with 1257) and 1131 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Scott Santos** with 1220). The score needed for a one round bye was 1201 (16th place). The senior cut was 1172. **Rich Valenti** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1123. **Jon Matunas** was the tournament high qualifier with 1338 on the 6pm squad with games of 279, 288, 235, 257 and 279. **Tim Healey** won the high game out of the money prize with 300. Ebonite Bashes were won by **Chris Rebstock** (1146 w/277 high game) and **Zachariah Riera** (Raffle). The field averaged 214.7 in qualifying and 215.1 for match play.

You know that he was one of the best bowlers because I found out who he was before I ever crossed the border into Long Island back in the late 80's. The only problem was he was better then I heard. For those of you who didn't know Chris just represented us in Naples Italy in the Bowlers Journal 2009 World Ranking Masters. I am sure that is just another great honor to go along with all the accomplishments you piled up over the years. Lastly I bowled against John Bedard who was looking for his first NEBA Title. All I can say is John you bowled a good enough game in that final match to win a championship. I came out on top but you can be proud of the game you bowled. Guys I respect each and every one of you and I had a great deal of fun competing against you all.

In short I feel NEBA has a bunch of real talented bowlers in it. I said it before and I will say it again, all bowlers can really improve their games by knocking heads with some of the best bowlers in New England. I thank you all for many good experiences.

Bear right off exit onto Wilbur Ave. (Route 103) and then take a left at the light onto Route 103 East. Follow Route 103 East 1.2 miles (through the light then straight). At the fork in the road, bear right onto Riverside Drive. The center is located across from water up on hill on the left.

From Hartford, CT: I-84 East to I-384 East to Route 6 East to I-95 to I-195 East & follow **above.

From Springfield, MA: I-90 East to I-495 South to Exit 7 (Route 24 South) & follow **above.

From Boston, MA, ME & NH: Take best route (I-93 or I-95 South) to Route 24 South to Route 79 South. Go across the Brighton St Bridge and take a left at the first light over the bridge.
