Flamand Returns with Win in New Bedford

Greg Flamand was a regular at NEBA up until about ten years ago. After he moved west, he only bowled one or two a year. In his second NEBA in three years, he won a title he didn't expect after so much time away. In East Providence, the 48 year-old earned a match play spot off the Saturday squad with 300, 217, 235, 215 and 279 for 1247. After receiving a bye as the #6 seed, the right-hander out distanced the match play field by averaging 239.2 and throwing the high game in 4 of his 5 rounds. The final match was close for the first half then Flamand took advantage of a single pin missed error by the rookie by tossing a triple. He got up needing a mark in the 9th or 10th to shut out DosSantos. A flush shot in the 9th gave Flamand his second title. He adds this win to his first from May 1999. He won \$1,700 plus a paid \$100 entry into the Ebonite T of C in November.

Chris DosSantos was on his way to win the first NEBA he entered before he came up against Flamand. He started his debut off with 1147 (227, 258, 203, 268 & 191) on Saturday night. The righty advanced to match play off the at-large list. The 20 year took advantage of the new rule change which allows youth members to compete. The \$1,000 he won will go into his USBC SMART account.
