# **PONTES CAPTURES THIRD TITLE**

**DEREK PONTES** from Swansea, MA won his third title with a 225-202 win over Chris Jolicoeur at Westgate Lanes. Derek enjoyed his first victory in June of 2005 at Auburn Lanes then his next at East Providence Lanes in 2007. The 33 year-old started the road to his championship on Saturday night. He shot games of 279, 176, 269, 231 and 248 for the second high score of the squad with 1203. His score held up for seventh out of the 161 entries which was good for a one round bye. In match play, the lefty eliminated 9-time champ Brian Boghosian (Agawam, MA) 235-188, Rob Mota (Dayville, CT) 174-157 then champions Steve Hardy (Manchester, NH) 258-234 and John Kirker (Taftville, CT) 215-165 for a well deserved spot in the final match. Derek started with an open but came on strong striking six out of the next eight frames including a huge four-bagger to take the lead. He got up in the tenth needing a spare to lock up the match. A slightly high hit resulted in a six pin standing. He picked up the spare and celebrated his latest win. Derek averaged 231.0 for his ten games in Brockton. He won \$1,250 plus a \$100 entry into the Tournament of Champions.

**CHRIS JOLICOEUR** from Woonsocket, RI was looking for his first win after competing in NEBA since 2001. In Brockton, the 31 year-old used games of 225, 165, 204, 242 and 242 for 1072 and a guaranteed spot in match play off the Sunday morning squad. In the first round, Chris shot 194 in the best 2 out of 3 round against Tom Andrelli's 203 and Del Picard's 172 to advance to round two. In head-to-head matches, he defeated #4 seed Rick Kirey (Scarsdale, NY) 236-203 then champion Brian Gaskill (Revere, MA) 216-170, Bob D'Antuono (Woonsocket, RI) 189-177 and 14 time champ Barry Warshafsky (Peabody, MA) 230-179 to advance to his first full-field championship match. Chris' highest previous finish is second at the non-champions in 2004. In the championship match, Chris had the lead until he left a split in the fourth frame. He continued to hit the pocket but couldn't keep up with Derek's strikes. Chris averaged 224.5 overall and took home \$750 for his runner-up finish.

There were 161 entries at Westgate Lanes which advanced forty bowlers into match play. There was a tie for the at-large cut at 1068 between three bowlers. The three bowlers had a ninth and tenth frame roll-off. Derek Moreau grabbed the last spot in match play with 50 against Jim Rusin's 36 and 27 by Brandon Robertson. Jim received a free paid entry and Brandon won an Ebonite ball. Squad cuts were 1141 on Saturday night (squad leader **Alex Aguiar** with 1303), 1102 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Tim Gillick** with 1149) and 1108 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Mike Rose** with 1304). The score needed for a one round bye was 1130 (16<sup>th</sup> place). The senior cut was 1052. **John Campo** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1047. **Mike Rose** was the tournament high qualifier with 1304 on the 12:30 squad with games of 257, 262, 248, 279 and 257. **John Rusin** won the high game out of the money prize with 279. The qualifying field averaged 201.6 and 207.7 was the average for matches.

Ebonite Complete NVs were won by Brandon Robertson (1068) and Nick Kallner (Raffle).

<u>Directions</u>: Bowl-O-Rama is located at 2143 Berlin Turnpike (Route 5), Newington, CT ~ Telephone (860)666-5411 \* It is best to check a map or on-line direction from your address since there are alternative routes \*

From New Haven, CT, NY & NJ: Take I-95 North to left exit 48 (I-91 North). \* Stay on I-91 North for 36 miles to exit 28 (Route 5 South/Route 15 South towards Wethersfield/Newington). Take Route 5 for 4 miles. Center is on right.

From Boston: Take I-90 West/Mass Pike to exit 9 (I-84 West towards Hartford) for 41 miles to

left exit 57 (Wilbur Cross Highway/Route 15 towards I-91 South / Charter Oak Bridge/NY City/Route 15). Continue on Route 15 that changes to Route 5 for 6.8 miles. Center on right.

From Providence (many other routes): Take I-95 North to exit 23 (Route 146 North toward Woonsocket) for 34 miles to Route 20/Auburn/I-90. Take I-90 West/Mass Pike then follow directions above for Boston.

From Springfield MA, NH, VT: Take I-91 South to exit 28 (Route 5 South/Route 15 South towards

Wethersfield/Newington). Continue on Route 5 for 4 miles. Center on right.

From Danbury, CT: Take I-84 East for 44 miles to left exit 35 (Route 72 East toward Route 9/New Britain). After 2.8 miles merge onto Route 9 North via the left exit. Take exit 29 (Route 175) then turn right onto Route 175/Cedar Street. After 2.7 miles merge onto Route 5 South/Route 15 South/Berlin Turnpike. Center is on right in 0.3 miles.
