Novara Wins First NEBA Title

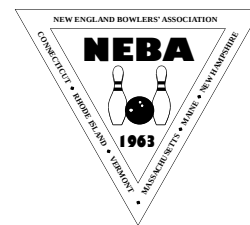
Joe Novara, the young 20 year old from East Patchogue, NY won his first NEBA title defeating James Burt with a score of 229 to 188 in the championship match. In only his second year bowling NEBA events, Novara is someone to watch for on the lanes. Last season, in the only event he bowled, he finished in 15th place. In his second appearance, he took home the first place trophy. At Bradley Bowl, he qualified in the 9 am squad with 191, 279, 224, 236, and 221 for a 5-game block of 1151. His superior bowling in qualifying allowed him to receive a bye in the first round of match play. He averaged 219.6 for five games in match play on the challenging pattern. In the final match, Novara's fiery start proved troublesome for Burt, who couldn't connect enough strikes to take over the champion. He won \$1,600 plus a \$100 paid entry into the Ebonite Tournament of Champs in November.

James Burt, from Walpole, MA made the cut in the final qualifying squad with a 5-game series of 1106 with games 188, 174, 257, 282, and 204. The 35 year old fought through some close matches en route to the championship match. His winning streak was ended when he met up with Novara. Novara starting with six strikes while Burt filled frames unable to double until the tenth frame. The 35 year-old ended the day with his highest finish in NEBA. After competing on and off since 1997, his previous high finish was sixth before ending in the runner-up spot at Bradley. Burt took home \$925 for his day of bowling.

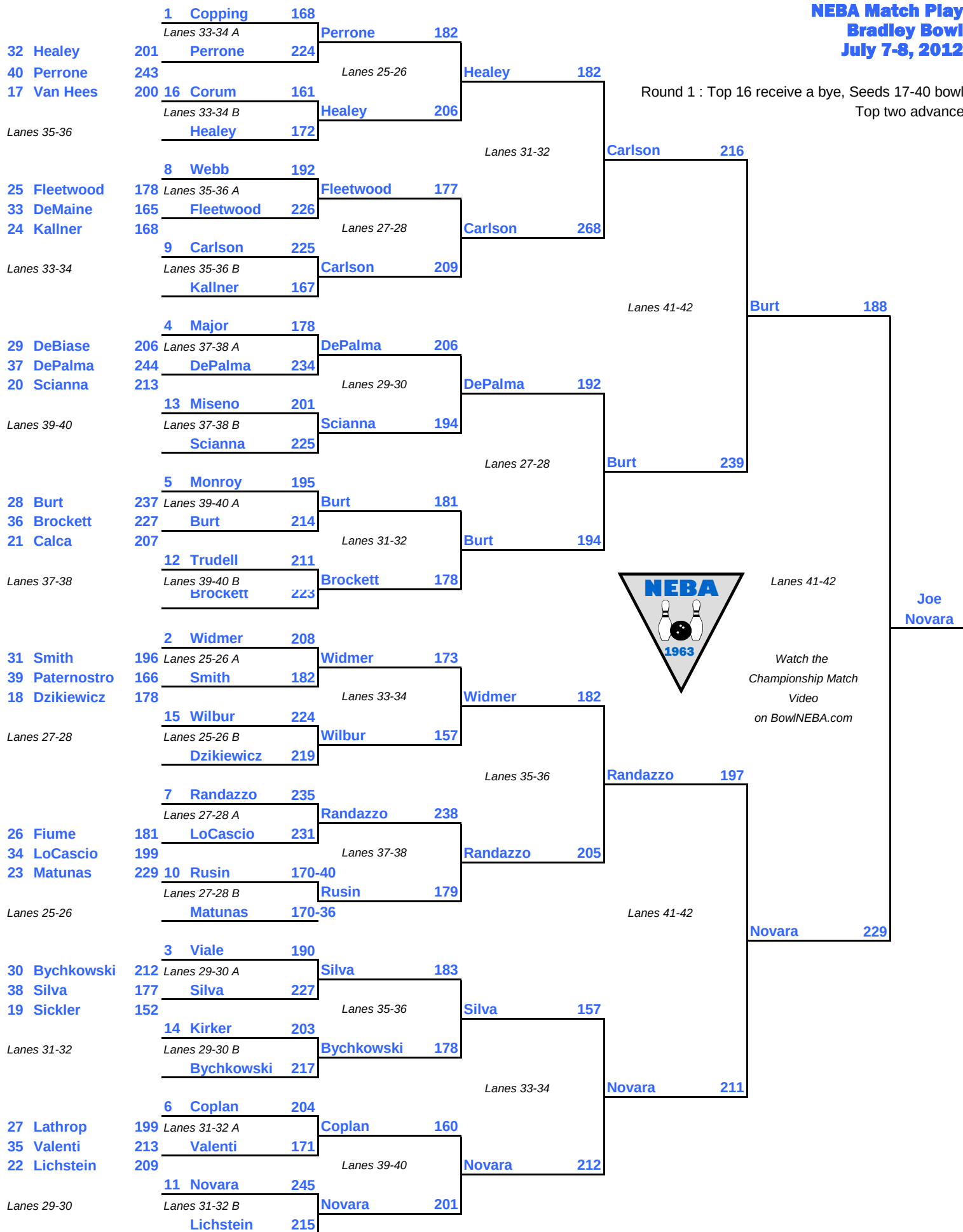
