Broege Outlasts Field to Win 7th Title

RJ Broege (West Hartford, CT) bowling against Frankie Calca (Elmont, NY) in the final match isn't a surprise. This is the third time they have bowled against each other for the title in the last 14 months. Calca won the first in March last year; Broege won the next in October then won this month to make it 2-1 in his favor. The latest win was the 30 year-old's seventh career title. Broege qualified for match play off the last squad with a 1025 on the challenging conditions. The left-hander advanced through match play averaging less than 200 which proves the lanes left little room for error. Broege started the championship with a double for the early led then the match turned grueling. Neither bowler threw another double and each had three opens to keep the match within ten pins from start to finish. After a missed spare in the tenth by Calca, the reigning bowler of the year needed a mark in the tenth to win.

Frankie Calca earned a guaranteed spot in match play with 1017 on the Saturday night squad. He cruised to the final match averaging 213.2 compared to his opponent's 167.2 average. Unfortunately, the 27 year-old threw his low game of the tournament in the final round against Broege. He won \$800 for his finish. Calca is having a very good year in NEBA. He has made five of six cuts in 2011 which puts him third on the points list.
