# Wujek & Fiume Dominate Doubles

Chris Wujek (Windsor, CT) & Steve Fiume (Fiskdale, MA) won the doubles at Cranston with gave Wujek his first title and Fiume his fourth. The duo dominated the event from start to finish. They shot games of 499, 388, 521, 438 and 474 to lead the last squad and all of qualifying with 2320, which was the only score which broke 300 over. In match play, they averaged 224.3 compared to the field average of 196.1 including the highest match play game of 527 in the first round on the demanding freshly oiled lanes. It is a rare occurrence for the high qualifier to make it to the championship match never mind win the tournament. Wujek & Fiume each received \$1,225 plus a paid \$100 entry into the T of C in November, a champions' shirt and a trophy. The pair will be able to defend their title at next year's summer doubles tournament.

Chris Carlson (Clinton, CT) & DeMaine (Enfield, CT) started the tournament with a 1919 on the Sunday morning squad the reentered to better their score with 2194 (458, 493, 457, 435, 351). After a bye, the right-handers climbed through the match play bracket. The fell behind Wujek & Fiume early in the championship match then were unable to make up any ground. Each took home \$725 for the runner-up finish.



#### $\rightarrow$ RULE REMINDERS $\leftarrow$

- No practice is allowed at the bowling center after the lanes are oiled on Saturday. This rule went into affect when we eliminated open paid practice in 2009. Once the lanes are oiled for the tournament, no bowlers may throw a ball in the center until they are done with bowling the tournament.
- Two types of shirts are allowed: 1) a polo type collar with no restrictions of branding or 2) a mock neck shirt from a bowling company or a NEBA sponsor. Each bowler must have their name on the back. A minimum of the last name is required. New bowlers have until their fourth tournament to meet the name requirement. Name tags/plates are allowed but must be neatly pinned or applied to the shirt.
- A bowler is responsible for being in compliance with the dress code even if a name tag or shirt is on order with NEBA.
- Fines must be paid before you enter the next tournament. Starting July 2011, you will be told on-site or contacted via email or regular mail before the next tournament if you have a fine.

99% of fines are for not having names on shirts. Per the rulebook, we could fine for many other things. We try to run the tournament well and not "overfine" the bowlers but we do need to enforce rules so everyone is playing by the same rules. As always, ask if you have any questions. - Becky
