WETZLER CONQUERS AMF HOLIDAY LANES FOR FIRST NEBA WIN

GEOFF WETZLER from Tolland, CT grabbed his first win with a convincing 220-167 championship match victory over champion Tim Healey. Geoff started his quest for his first title at Holiday Lanes with 278, 229, 180, 200 and 218 on the 9 a.m. squad. His 1105 was towards the bottom of the at-large. After lots of thinking, he decided not to reenter which ended up being the right decision. In the first round of the top 40, Geoff's 241 got him through the best of three round against Keith DeMaine and Scott Santos. In head-to-head matches, the right-hander was victorious over #2 seed Chad Autore (Naugatuck, CT) 211-198, champions Keith DeMaine (East Hartford, CT) 216-206 and Mike Cordeiro (Walpole, MA) 213-210 and Angel Hernandez (Branford, CT) in a tenth frame nail-biter 189-179. In his second career championship match, Geoff started off slow but filled frames with spares to stay within a few pins of his opponent. He jumped on an open in the 8th by Tim by throwing the first triple of the match. A missed spare in the 10th by Tim gave Geoff the match. Geoff, who started bowling NEBA at 19 in 1999, won \$1,250 plus a \$100 entry into next month's Tournament of Champions.

TIM HEALEY from Cranston, RI shot games of 226, 213, 279, 231 and 201 for 1150 to earn a guaranteed spot into match play off the Sunday morning squad. After a one round bye for qualifying 12th, the 27 year-old lefty defeated Del Picard (Fall River, MA) 214-202 then champions Derek Pontes (Swansea, MA) 227-202 and Frank Calca (Elmont, NY) 203-171. Tim left the left the semi-final match in his opponent Rob Mota's (Dayville, CT) hands; Rob needed 9 on two balls but left the 4-6-7-10 to give Tim the 191-190 win and the spot in the championship match. Tim won last month's tournament so he was looking for back-to-back titles but his sore back and fine bowling by Geoff got in the way of that accomplishment.

There were 162 entries at AMF Holiday Lanes which was just one entry above the minimum for 40 match play finalists. Nathan Abdow led qualifying with games of 279, 247, 257, 239 and 253 for 1275 on the Saturday night squad. The at-large cut was 1088 but since two bowlers were not present for roll call, the cut dropped to 1082. Scott Santos won a 9th and 10th frame roll-off over John Rusin to grab the final spot in match play. John received a paid entry. Squad cuts were 1129 on Saturday night (leader Nathan Abdow with 1275), 1137 at 9 a.m. (leader Chad Autore with 1229) and 1085 at 12:30 p.m. (leader **Ryan Burlone** with 1222). There were only 11 senior entries guaranteeing one into match play. High senior was 1145. The score needed for a one round bye was 1141 (16th place). **Chris Sole** won the \$50 high game out of money prize with 279. Ebonite Clashes were won by **Stephen Dale Jr.** (1088) and **Rick Cashell** (raffle). The field average in qualifying was 204.0 and 205.5 for matches. **Honor Scores**: 300 by Jason Hebert & Tim Gillick (9 a.m.)

**Take exit 2 (Route 372/New Britain Avenue). Turn left onto New Britain Avenue/Route 372. Center in 0.2 miles.

From Boston, MA (112 miles), ME & NH: Take best route to I-90 West for 55 miles to exit 9 (I-84 West for 56 miles through Hartford) to Exit 33 (Route 72 toward Plainville) and follow **above.

From Providence, RI (110 miles): Take Route 6 West/I-195 West to I-95 South (left exit for 69 miles) to exit 69 (Route 9 North towards Hartford for 35 miles) to exit 28 on left (Route 72 West toward Bristol) to exit 33 then follow **above.

- 1. Reports of Officers & Tournament Director Summaries
- 2. Elected officers for 2009-2010 No nominations for 2nd Vice President, one nomination for Sec/Treasurer.
- 3. Board Member at Large Applications due December 1
- 4. Discuss Proposed Bylaw Changes (to be acted upon at Annual Meeting):
 - a. Change requirement of a Board Member at Large to apply in writing to NEBA President by December 1 -to- December 31 -or- date of Annual Meeting.
 - b. Change requirement for tournament sites from a minimum of 40 lanes -to- 40 lanes for open singles tournaments and 26 lanes for special tournaments.
 - c. Remove: Bowling fees, lane availability, and bowling center staff support stated in writing by the proprietor/manager ninety (90) days in advance of the tournament.
- 5. Discuss Proposed Tournament Bylaws (to be acted upon at Annual Meeting):
 - a. In doubles events, allow champions to bowl with champions who have not won a title in the last fifteen years.
 - b. In doubles events, change rule from no more to one champion per team -to- no more than 1 multi-time champion per team, "multi-time" being defined as a bowler with 2 or more NEBA titles.
 - c. In doubles events, allow bowlers to switch partners.
 - d. Increase the minimum to cash ratio from 1 in 5 -to-1 in 5.5 (chart of entries to be presented at meeting)

- e. Increase optional side pools from \$20 -to- \$40
- 6. Other Proposed Tournament Bylaw Changes to be discussed which did not meet the requirements to be guaranteed to be on the annual agenda:
 - a. Raise entry fee to \$85
 - b. Eliminate Paid Practice on Tournament Lanes This proposal would eliminate paid practice and increase lineage rate which currently is between \$1.50 and \$2.00 to \$3.00 a game for all centers thus increasing the entry fee a minimum of \$6 to cover increase in lineage.
 - c. Increase the amount of practice during the first round of match play 5 minutes to 10.
 - d. Strip & oil the lanes before match play -or- Strip & oil the lanes before match play when time allows.
- 7. Annual Meeting Agenda
- 8. Tournament of Champions Change minimum guaranteed into match play from 16 -to- 12.
- 9. Non-Champions Allow 6 per pair if needed.
- 10. Point Leader Invitational Added money, format, should it be on 2010 schedule
- 11. Committee Reports Hall of Fame, 2009 Schedule, Marketing, etc.
- 12. Sponsors for 2009
- 13. Tournament of Champion Entry Fee Discuss injured member's request that his 2008 entry be used in 2009
