Lango Jr. & DeMaine Win Doubles Titles Father Son Duo of Joey & Roger Baral Shoot 600

Don Lango Jr & Keith DeMaine defeated the team of Norm Major & Dan White in the baker style championship match to win the doubles tournament at East Providence Lanes. In qualifying, the duo shot 2295 on the Sunday morning squad then failed at bettering their score on a reentry. Their first score grabbed the last spot in the match play field of 32 teams which meant the played the #1 seed the first round. After eliminating that team of Larsen/Santos 460-425, the easily went through the field including a 570 (270 plus 300) in the semi-finals. In the championship match, they won the first game 236-193 then added 220-191 for the tournament win. This was the first title for Lango and the fourth for DeMaine who captured his first title in 1994. Each bowler received \$900 plus a paid \$100 entry into the T of C in November, a white champions' shirt and a trophy.

Norm Major & Dan White had a similar start to their opponent. They shot 2307 on the Sunday morning squad to put them in the middle of the at large list. They bowled again to raise the number of entries over the minimum needed to take 32 into match play but didn't better their score and snuck into match play with their first score. They started match play with a 548, 464 and 492 then slowed down with striking the last two rounds while they scored 415 and 384. This was Major's highest finish while White was looking for his third title.

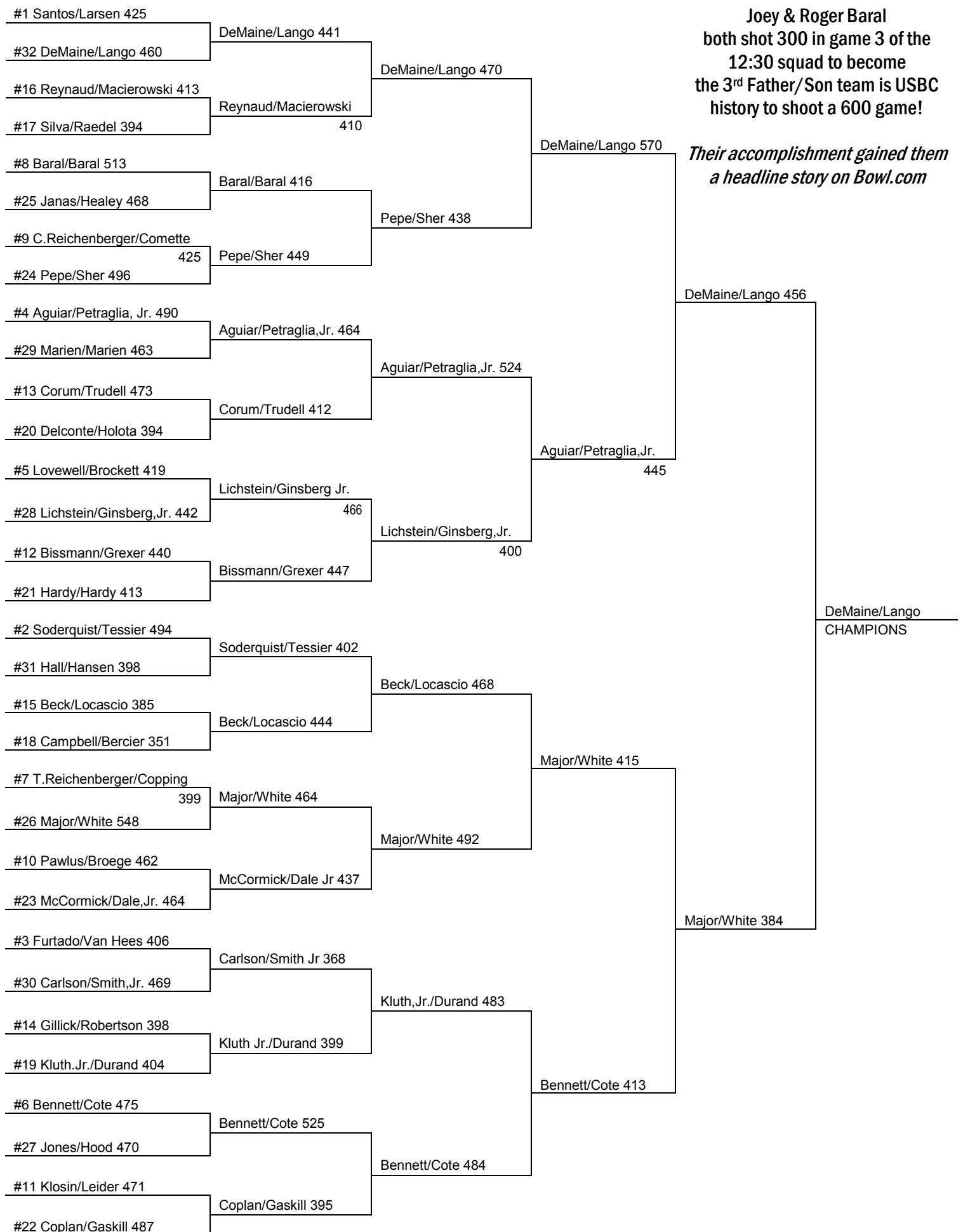
