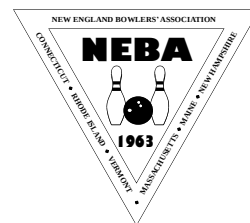

Webb Moves Up All Time List with 14th Win

Bill Webb from Guilford, CT moved up a spot to second on the list of all-time champions with his win at AMF Silver Lanes. His 14th win puts him in a tie with fellow NEBA legends Chris Rebstock and Barry Warshafsky behind Michael Lichstein's 27 titles. In East Hartford, Webb earned himself the #2 seed in match play and a first round bye by leading the 9:00AM squad with 213, 222, 256, 226 and 210 for 1127. His side of the bracket included several NEBA veterans who were vying for their own spot in the championship match. The 40 year-old faced off with 5-time titlist and recent senior champ George Tignor first. After topping Tignor 236-181, he defeated 7-time champ RJ Broege 201-184 then drew Jon Van Hees in the quarter finals. Webb eliminated the 5-time champ, 233-213 for a spot on the TV show. The 7-time Bowler of the Year advanced to the championship match after besting his National

USBC teammate Chris Viale 212-196. Their team, Cambridge Credit 1 has finished in the top 10 the past two years at the Open Championships. Webb was able to conquer the changing lane conditions once more, beating Hamm 227-175 to claim victory and the \$1,450 first place prize along with a \$100 paid entry into the Ebonite Tournament of Champions.

Derek Hamm from Raynham, MA earned a guaranteed spot in match play on the last squad with 1074 (245, 192, 187, 226, 224). The 23-year old advanced through his side of the bracket, securing a spot on the TV show with a quarter final match victory over 6-time titlist Ed Roberts. After a slow start in the semis, Hamm responded to needing a mark in the tenth to win by tossing a strike. He was unable to keep up with Webb in the final match. Hamm's previous high was a top 16 finish last year.

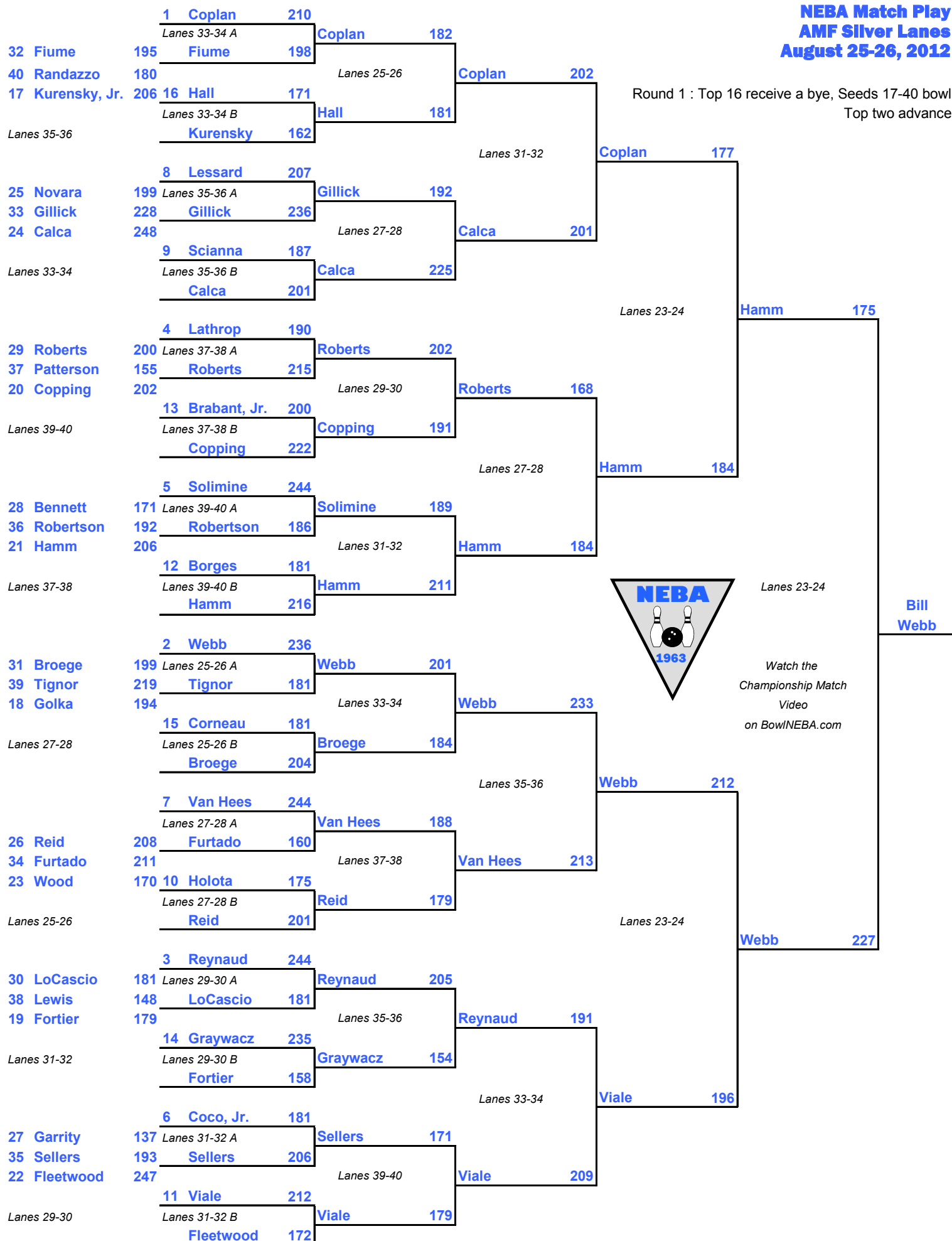
1. Tournament Summaries

8. 50th Anniversary Tournament – Promotion (\$200-\$250 for last cash spot), added money, extra Saturday squad, Satellite tournament, gift, program booklet, sponsors for booklet
9. Senior Tournament – Do not re-oil the lanes between qualifying and match play in senior tournaments.

11. Side pots and Brackets – report since change earlier this year
