LEGENDARY ROTH WINS AT WESTGATE

MARK ROTH from Fulton, NY beat Steve Wagoner, Broadalbin, NY, 226-191 to win NEBA's annual visit to Brockton's Westgate Lanes. Mark. 56 years old, was in town for an exhibition organized by Ray Disanto Jr. of USA Bowling Pro Shop on Saturday. He came up short on the added 3PM qualifying squad with a 1066 then earned a guaranteed spot in match play with games of 255, 259, 194, 213 and 237 for 1158 on the last qualifying squad on Sunday. Arguably the greatest clutch bowler of all time went to work in the match play finals on champion Chris Forry (Bridgeport, CT) 225-146 and Bob Sieff (Durham, CT) 234-213 then multiple titlists Chris Sole (Feeding Hills, MA) 223-195, Alex Aguiar (North Dartmouth, MA) 247-225 and Steve Blanchet (Methuen, MA) 208-200. In the championship match, both Mark and his opponent each missed the pocket once but the difference was Mark filled every frame. It was a ten pin match through frame five then Mark threw a triple to take the lead. Mark finished with a triple to give him the win at NEBA's year end event and a \$3,000 first place prize. Roth's list of bowling credentials includes four time PBA Player of the Year with the latest coming in 1984, 34 national PBA titles, two national PBA senior titles and the 1984 BPAA US Open hosted by Oak Lawn, IL which was his only major. Mark joins Paul Moser as the only NEBA champion to win the US Open. Moser captured his title in 1976 in Grand Prairie, TX. In 1978 Mark won 8 times which, at one time, was regarded as the greatest single season in PBA history.

STEVE WAGONER from Broadalbin made it an all New York finals at Westgate Lanes. The right-hander doesn't compete regularly in NEBA but finds success when he does. He caught everyone's attention when he made it to the semi-finals in his first tournament at Silver Lanes in 2006. Since then, he has qualified in 10 of the 15 tournaments he bowled with three top four finishes. This year in Brockton, the 30 year old reentered the last squad after shooting 1026 Sunday morning. He put together games of 188, 252, 222, 211 and 248 for 1121, which was enough for the top spot on the at-large list. In match play, Steve averaged an impressive 250.0 en route to the championship match against Pete Bostick (Glastonbury, CT) 225-224, #8 seed Mike Budwick (Templeton, MA) 279-199, 2007 Rookie of the Year Frankie Calca (Elmont, NY) 257-237, recent champion Eric Copping (Websterville, NY) 225-180 and 3 time winner Vic Marotto (Wallingford, CT) 268-213. In the final match, Steve wasn't able to continue to string strikes and had to settle for a runner-up finish. He won \$1,700 for his bowling in Brockton.

There were 278 entries at the year end open singles event with major sponsors Harry's Pub & Grill and Liquid Advertising. The at-large cut for 56th place was 1109. The score needed to receive a one round bye (8th place) was 1188. The senior cut was 1111. Squad cuts were 1114 (leader **Eric Copping** with 1319) on the added Saturday 3 p.m., 1124 (leader **Matt Brown** with 1174) on Saturday 6 p.m., 1113 (leader **Chris Sole** with 1263) on Sunday 9 a.m. and 1124 (leader **Tom Durand** with 1254) on Sunday afternoon. **Eric Copping** ended the 3PM squad with back-to-back 300's to lead the tournament with 1319 (222-221-276-300-300). **Anthony Green** shot 288 to win the high game out of the money prize of \$50. **Mark Talmadge** won the \$50 prize for the highest senior who did not make the cut with 1083. The Ebonite Total NVs were won by **Brian Boghosian** (1108) and **Ralph Ehrlich** (Raffle). Scores were higher than last year. 210.6 was the qualifying average and 216.1 was the average for matches.
