## Autore \& Forry Double Up for Win in Cranston

CHAD AUTORE from Naugatuck, CT $\mathcal{\&}$ CHRIS FORRY from Fairfield, CT defeated the team of John Conroy \& Billy Webb, 449-438, to capture the Coveted NEBA Doubles at AMF's Cranston Bowl. The right handed duo qualified off the 12:30 squad with games of $480,381,430,490 \& 436$. The 2,21710 -game total qualified them ninth for the always exciting match play finals. Autore \& Forry began their march to the championship match with a 436-404 win over John Koufos \& Barry Warshafsky. The Talented team followed with wins over Mike Cardullo and 2007 Bowler of the Year Russ Michaud, 444-389, Chris Hall \& Tom Hansen, 435-395, and Matt Cardullo \& Steve Dale Jr., 428-423, to set up the showdown with John Conroy \& NEBA's best Billy Webb. Chad and Chris wouldn't have had it any other way as the match came down to the tenth frame. Conroy \& Webb had a twelve pin lead after seven frames then a double by Forry brought it within three. With a strike up in the ninth, Autore threw a huge strike in the tenth to take the lead then followed it with two more. Forry, also working on a strike needed a strike to lock up the match, but a four pin stood on a clutch shot, which gave Webb the opportunity to win for his team by throwing a double. Anchor man Webb was money in the tenth frame, throwing a must have strike on his first attempt, but the $7-10$ split stood on his second shot and Autore \& Forry escaped with the win. For the win Autore \& Forry earned $\$ 1,700$ plus a paid entry into the Tournament of Champions later this year. This was Autore's first title and Forry's third. His first was at Laurel Lanes in April 2002 and his next came in 2003 with doubles partner Bill Gross.

JOHN CONROY from Mahopac, NY \& BILL WEBB from Enfield, CT qualified sixth for the finals from the popular 9:00 AM squad with games of $473,415,386,425 \& 537$. Entering the finals with 2,236 as the sixth seed, they then went to work on Chris Jolicoeur \& Dave Forcier, 456-431, Pat McCarthy \& Sleepy Hollow legend Bobby Glenn, 456-406, and Justin Warhol \& Bobby Volk, 448-382, for a shot at the doubles crown. As stated above, the final match was intense from start to finish but it was Autore \& Forry who took home the championship trophy while Conroy \& Webb earned $\$ 1,120$ in the runner-up slot.
There were 101 team entries at the doubles tournament, which advanced twenty-four teams into match play. The at-large cut was 2084. Squad cuts were 2087 on Saturday night (squad leader Jim Rougier \& Dave Reali with 2144), 2147 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Rob Mota \& Brian Boghosian with 2878) and 2197 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader Frankie Calca \& Nick Kallner with 2296). The score needed for a one round bye was 2218 ( $8^{\text {th }}$ place). The team of Rob Mota \& Brian Boghosian was the tournament high qualifier with 2378 on the 9AM squad. Bob D'Antuono \& William Tessier won the high game out of the money prize with 486. Ebonite balls were won by Rick Petrucelli \& RJ Broege (2081).
