HALL WINS SECOND TITLE

CHRIS HALL from Waterford, CT continued his great 2008 with a win at Lang's Lanes with a 216-162 championship match victory over fellow champion Jon Van Hees. This was Chris' fourth top eight finish out of the eight tournaments this year and second championship match appearance. His win propelled him to the top of the Bowler of the Year point list. The 28 year-old put together games of 258, 197, 247, 218 and 204 for 1124 on the Saturday night squad. With his score towards the top of the at-large list, he sat out the last squad and waited for match play to begin. In the elimination round, his 248 against TJ Souza's 198 and 188 by Matt Janas advanced him to round two. In matches, Chris did not use his Action or Fired up but a new Columbia Momentum to average 234 against Jon Matunas (Newington, CT) 213-151 then lefties Scott Santos (Ledyard, CT) 246-234, Steve Jones (Manchester, CT) 237-158 and Steve Hardy (Manchester, NH) 245-217. In the championship match, Chris tossed shots for mostly strikes while his opponent struggled to fill frames; easily giving him his second NEBA title. He won \$1,450 plus a paid entry into the Tournament of Champions as well as another trophy to add to his first from 2004. This is a long awaited win for the young lefty who has had five runner-up finishes since his first title.

CHRIS: X 9/ X X X 9/ X 9/ x 9/ s8-1 = 216 JON: X 9/ X s7-2 s5-3 X 9- X 9- XX9 = 162 JON VAN HEES from Newport, RI earned a guaranteed spot off the Saturday night squad with 259, 221, 189, 300 and 222 for 1191 for third on the squad. That gives the strapping righty 300's in back-to-back tournaments. As the #8 seed, he sat out the first round with a bye then defeated newly converted two-hander Tony Federici (Portchester, NY) 257-164, reigning Bowler of the Year Russ Michaud (Hudson, NH) 227-192 then champions Eric Copping (Websterville, VT) 248-177 and Brian Gaskill (Revere, MA) 209-204. The 27 year-old suffered a couple wide open splits in the first half of the final match making it impossible to put any pressure on the red hot Chris Hall. Since Jon won Rookie of the Year and the non-champions in 2001, he has not bowled regularly but when he does, he finds much success. In 2008, he has made all of the cuts in the five tournaments he competed and is third on the average list. Jon averaged 229 for his eleven games in Cranston and took home \$850 for second

place.

There were 175 entries at which advanced forty bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1086. Squad cuts were 1150 on Saturday night (squad leader **Dave Forcier** with 1271), 1106 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Steve Hardy** with 1244) and 1113 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Eric Copping** with 1277). The score needed for a one round bye was 1150 (16th place). The senior cut was 1131. **Jim Sansone** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1077. **Eric Copping** was the tournament high qualifier with 1277 on the Sunday morning squad with games of 265, 290, 236, 249 and 237. **Larry King & Randy Hagemoser** split the high game out of the money prize with 289 games. - From Boston, MA, ME & NH: Take I-90 West (MA. Tpke.) to exit 9 (I-84 West). Take exit 58 (Roberts St./Silver Lane) then bear right onto Roberts Street (0.2 miles). Take a right onto Simmons Road and follow road to end (0.4 miles). Take a left onto Silver Lane and the center is 0.3 miles on the left.
- From Hartford & Waterbury, CT: ** Take I-84 East to Exit 58 (Roberts St./Silver Lane/Burnside Ave.) Bear to the right off the exit ramp and make a left at the light onto Silver Lane. Silver Lanes is 0.8 miles on the left.
- From NYC & New Haven, CT: Take I-95 North to I-91 North to exit 29 (CT 15 North/Wilbur Cross towards I-84 East). Take exit 91 (Silver Lane) towards Roberts St. Take slight right onto Silver Lane. Center in 1.3 miles.
- From Springfield, MA, Albany, NY & VT: Take best route to I-91 South into CT. Follow I-91 South to exit 30 (I-84 East) and follow **above
