## Healey Finds Remedy in Auburn for First NEBA Title

TIM HEALEY from Cranston, RI won his first title by a narrow 243-235 victory over 26-time champion Michael Lichstein. In Auburn, the 27 year-old put together games of $246,206,225,258$ and 248 for 1183 on the Sunday morning squad to earn a guaranteed spot in the afternoon matches. After qualifying seventh and receiving a bye, Tim defeated 2 -time champion Scott Widmer (Canton, CT) 232-218, Anthony Valentine (New Milford, CT) 255-201, John Williston (Worcester, MA) 234-213 and 6-time champ Chris Sole (Feeding Hills, MA) 217-186. Tim started slow in his championship match debut. A couple missed pocket shots left him down 23 pins halfway through the match but as his opponent started to strike so did he. Michael went through the nose in the ninth on a four-bagger to let Tim back in the match. Tim finished first making impressive clutch shots to force his rival to throw a double for the win. Michael got the first strike then left a ringing seven in the eleventh giving Tim his first title. After a handful of top four finishes competing in NEBA for over ten years, Tim added his name to the list of NEBA champions by averaging 236.4 for his ten games and throwing great shots when needed like a true champion does. Tim won $\$ 1,200$ plus a $\$ 100$ paid entry into the Tournament of Champions and a white champion's shirt.

MICHAEL LICHSTEIN from Broad Brook, CT also advanced for match play by earning a guaranteed spot off the Sunday morning squad. He used games of $211,247,257,213$ and 216 for 1144 . His score held up for $12^{\text {th }}$ overall which gave him a round bye. In matches, the 39 year-old put threw big games against Point Leader Champion Tom Durand (West Haven, CT) 247-246, Tim Hansen (Higganum, CT) 257-182, NEBA's only 6-time Bowler of the Year Bill Webb (Enfield, CT) 226-174 and champion Ollie Ellard (Chicopee, MA) 258-231 for his first championship match appearance since his last win in Hamden last September. After having a good size lead, a seven pin in the eleventh stood between NEBA's most winningest bowler and his $27^{\mathrm{t}}$ title. In the 22 years Michael has competed in NEBA, he has amassed many records and honors in addition to his record-breaking wins. The lefty averaged 236.7 for ten games and took home $\$ 750$ for his runner-up finish.
There were 161 entries which was enough to take forty bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1085 . Squad cuts were 1137 on Saturday night (squad leader Matt Brockett with 1141), 1121 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Chris Viale with 1235) and 1078 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leaders Pete Bostick \& RJ Broege with 1177). The score needed for a one round bye was 1126 ( $16^{\text {th }}$ place). The senior cut was 1061. Russ Michaud won the extra $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1052. Chris Viale was the tournament high qualifier with 1235 on the Sunday morning squad with games of 210, 289, 278, 237 and 221. Bill Tessier won the $\$ 50$ high game out of the money prize with 279. Ebonite Clashes were won by Tim Gillick ( 1077 with 268 high game) and Steve Cloutier (raffle). The average in qualifying was 201.7 and 215.6 in matches.
