## Broege Goes Back-to-Back at TofC

RJ BROEGE from West Hartford, CT became the first bowler to successfully defend a Tournament of Champions title with a convincing 525-406 championship match win over Bill Holota. After shooting 1239 in qualifying, the 29 year-old lefty dominated the field during match play by averaging 252.7 and led scoring in all but one round which made him the favorite going into the final match. In match play he was the only player to surpass the 500 mark as he defeated Stephen Dale Jr. (Newton, NH) 481-478, Tim Healey (Cranston, RI) 530-491, Darrell Guertin (Shrewsbury, MA) 486-452 and Bill Holota (Bolton, CT) 525-406. Broege's performance in New Bedford gives him his fifth title and moves him up to third on the points list. He joins Dick Millward $(1993,1995)$ and Chris Rebstock $(1998,2007)$ as the only bowlers who have won the TofC twice since its inception in 1993 but he stands alone as being the only one with back-to-back Tournament of Champions titles. Broege won $\$ 1,475$ and a paid entry into the 2010 TofC to see if he can make it three in-a-row.

BILL HOLOTA from Bolton, CT also stood out from the field at Wonder Bowl. His 1268 was one pin short of leading qualifying and he shot the only 300 out of the strong tournament field. In matches, he was victorious over Jaison Haynes (Hamden, CT) 444-427, Geoff Wetzler (Tolland, CT) 440-402 and Scott Widmer (Canton, CT) 467-460 before falling to Broege in the championship match. The 36 year-old took home $\$ 950$ for his runner-up finish while averaging 219.6 in matches and 232.6 for the day. Holota owns two titles which he won in 1996.
There were 53 entries at the 2009 Tournament of Champions. Six who had paid entries into the tournament did not bowl so their $\$ 100$ entry fee was added directly to the prize fun. The cut to match play was 1182 ( $16^{\text {th }}$ place). Bill Green was the tournament high qualifier with 1269 with games of 261, 234, 226, 279 and 279. Tom Andrelli won the $\$ 50$ high game out of the money prize with 289. The field average for qualifying was 224.5 and 227.5 in match play.

## JASON BAKER GRABS NON-CHAMPIONS TROPHY

JASON BAKER from Sharon Springs, NY added his name to the list of 377 champions in the 47 year history of NEBA with a victory at the non-champions tournament in New Bedford. Baker started the day with games of 238, 246, 234, 228 and 206 for 1152 which placed him fourth on the at-large list. After qualifying $27^{\text {th }}$, he advanced through the best 2 of 3 round with a 236 game against Bryan Thomas' 205 and 182 by Jimmy Sicard then he defeated \#10 Joey Transue (Bradford, RI) 232-203, Jason Sherwood (Bridgewater, MA) 222-206, Chris Carlson (Clinton, CT) 234-140 and Mark Mantere (Billerica, MA) 232-213 en route to the final match. The 34 year-old threw a great game to defeat local favorite Robert Dessert 268-200. He won $\$ 1,900$ plus a paid entry into the Tournament of Champions the next day and he averaged 234.1 for the day. Unfortunately, Baker was unable to bowl the next day on such short notice. In his first year competing in NEBA, the 34 year-old has cashed in four out of the five tournaments he bowled including two championship match appearances. This win moved him into second in points for Rookie of the Year.

ROBERT DESSERT didn't have to drive far from his New Bedford, MA home to spend his Saturday at Wonder Bowl. He shot games of $182,245,221,223$ and 257 for 1128 on the first squad. This tied him for tenth on the at-large list which later became a 3 -way tie for the cut. In a $9^{\text {th }}-10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off, he defeated James Bessette and Randy Hagemoser for the $40^{\text {th }}$ spot in match play. He then advanced through the field to do what few do - move from the last spot to the championship match. In the first round, Dessert shot 247 against John Dow's 235 and 194 by David Kipperman to go up against the high qualifier Adam Younger. He eliminated the top seeded Younger (Acushnet, MA) 238-187, Clayton Jenkins (Acushnet, MA) 212-193, Del Picard Jr. (Westport, MA) 206-178 and Bob Sieff (Durham, CT) 247-192 in the semi-finals. He started off strong in the final match but wasn't able to keep up with the pace of his opponent. Dessert averaged 223.9 and won $\$ 1,150$ for second place.
There were 183 entries in New Bedford which exceeded last year's high entry. Forty bowlers advanced into match play with a 3 -way tie for the at-large cut at 1128. In the $9^{\text {th }}-10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off, Robert Dessert defeated James Bessette and Randy Hagemoser to earn the last spot in match play. Squad cuts were 1168 at 10AM (squad leader Chris Carlson with 1232) and 1130 at 1:30PM. (squad leader Adam Younger with 1233). The score needed for a one round bye was 1176. Doug Chapman won the extra $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1109. Adam Younger was the tournament high qualifier with 1233 on the afternoon squad with games of 201, 228, 279, 279 and 246. Danny Khuu won the $\$ 50$ high game out of the money prize with 287 . The field averaged 209.1 in qualifying and 215.0 for matches.
