CAVAGNARO & PEPE TEAM UP FOR BAKER TITLE

ALEX CAVAGNARO & ANTHONY PEPE worked together to win the baker doubles tournament with a high scoring 530-476 2-game championship match victory over Matt O'Grady & Alex Aguiar. Cavagnaro & Pepe qualified off the last squad on Sunday with 2219 after shooting 2147 on the morning squad. After qualifying 25th, they defeated Mike Marotto & Vic Marotto 446-352, Joey Baral & Roger Baral 401-394, High Qualifier Mike Bissman & Rob Grexer 442-403 and Mike Centrone & John Ferraro 528-388 in the semi-finals. The scores and intensity elevated in the championship match. Both teams started the first game with 8 strikes. O'Grady & Aguiar took a 16 pin lead after game one. Cavagnaro & Pepe kept the striking going while their opponents struggled to carry. This was the first NEBA win for both of the New York players. They each won \$1,000 plus a \$100 entry into the Tournament of Champions in November.

MATT O'GRADY & ALEX AGUIAR started their weekend off with a 2254 on the Saturday night squad. This placed the duo second on the at-large list which easily made the tournament cut. In matches, they defeated Glenn Hood & Bill Webb 484-458, Mitch Sacks & Mike Mullin 456-437, Tony Bennett & Jesse Cote 470-426 then Dave Kipperman & Tim Gillick 473-438 for a spot in the championship match. Two clean games wasn't enough to take home the win. The team split \$1,300 for their runner-up finish. This finish increased Aguiar's lead in Bowler of the Year to 38 with four tournaments left in 2009.

95 teams combined for 132 entries at East Providence Lanes. Saturday was quiet but it was a very busy Sunday. Both squads filled with 60 teams and teams who wanted to bowl were turned away. The at-large cut for 32 teams was 2205. Squad cuts were 2273 at 6PM (16 teams, squad leader **Brockett/Monroy**), 2210 at 9AM (60 teams, squad leader **Pawlus/Broege**) and 2249 at 12:30PM (60 teams, **Bissman/Grexer**). There were no byes or senior cuts. Rookie leader **Mike Bissman** joined with **Rob Grexer** to lead qualifying with 2240 on the last squad. **Tom Hansen & Brandon Robertson** won high game out of the money with 522. An Ebonite Lanebreaker and a Magic Touch were won by **Eric Stengel & Dan Furman** for being the first team to miss the cut with their 2202. Honor scores: **300** by **Chris Viale**, **11 in-a-row** by **Ian Lang** at 9AM (297), **Ian Lang** (299) at 12:30 & **Brandon Robertson** at 9AM (296). The field average for qualifying was 211.57 and went up to 217.63 in the baker matches.

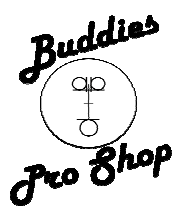
