



## HAYNES BECOMES NEBA'S NEWEST CHAMPION

**JAISON HAYNES** from Hamden, CT didn't show any nerves as he turned his first appearance in match play into his first tournament win. Haynes joined NEBA in 2002 and bowled one tournament a year until 2009 when he started bowling regularly and gained experience. He found success by advancing to match play in his seventh tournament this season with an 1141 on the last qualifying squad (games of 227, 202, 235, 289, and 188). He started match play off strong by shooting the high game of the first round, 266, to advance over Frankie Calca's 214 and 152 by Rob Corbett. Haynes kept going with victories over current rookie leader Mike Bissmann (Flushing, NY) 226-178 then champions Rob Grexer (Douglaston, NY) 226-206, Mike Cordeiro (Walpole, MA) 203-190 and Chris Viale (Westfield, MA) 223-215. Jaison calmly entered the final match filling frames. Midway through the match, Calca had a slight lead. A pocket 7-10 in the 7<sup>th</sup> swung the lead to Haynes. Haynes took advantage of his opponent's misfortune by throwing a double. Calca threw a strike in the 9<sup>th</sup> then a less than perfect shot in the tenth which resulted in a 6-pin. Haynes got up in the tenth needing a mark and good count to win his first NEBA. A quality shot resulted in a 7 pin. After making the spare, he needed 7 pins on the fill ball and tossed a strike. It was an impressive showing by the 33 year-old who won \$1,200 and a paid entry into the Tournament of Champions plus the honor of wearing a white shirt.

**FRANKIE CALCA** from Elmont, NY snagged the last guaranteed spot in match play on the Saturday night squad with 1169. He started off somewhat slowly with 180 then shot 226, 225, 280 and 258. The next day in matches, he continued striking. In the first round, Calca's 214 advanced him along with eventual champion Haynes over Rob Corbett. The 25 year-old put up some numbers, averaging 258, as he plowed through a field of champions including wins over Bill Holota (Bolton, CT) 267-225, Scott Widmer (Canton, CT) 234-204, Chris Gauvin (South Grafton, MA) 280-195 and Chris Sole (Feeding Hills, MA) 250-201. Calca bowled well in his third championship match of the year. He didn't miss the pocket but fell short to NEBA's newest champion. The left-hander is one of the top bowlers in NEBA this year. Earlier in the year he was sitting second in points, then took off a few months in the summer before he got married, then came back strong. Calca joins Bill Webb as the only bowler in 2009 to make the cut in every tournament they entered. He owns three titles including the 2006 Tournament of Champions.

There were 171 entries at Wallingford Bowl. The last time that building hosted a tournament was in 1996 when it was TBowl. Forty bowlers advanced to match play with the at large being 1143. Squad cuts were 1169 on Saturday night (squad leader **Chris Rebstock** with 1327), 1169 at 9 a.m. (squad leader **Randy Hagermoser** with 1338) and 1128 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader **Chris Hall** with 1268). The score needed for a one round bye was 1169 (16<sup>th</sup> place). The senior cut was 1132 with four advancing out of the 24 entries. **Bob Sieff** won the extra \$50 senior prize with 1109. **Randy Hagermoser** was the tournament high qualifier with 1338 on the Sunday morning squad with games of 279, 290, 290, 238 and 241. **Dave Kipperman** won the high game out of the money prize with 300. Ebonite balls were won by **Rich Macierowski** (1135) and **Rob Greene** (raffle). The field averaged 211.4 in qualifying and 220.2 during matches.

## Minutes of the Meeting held November 8<sup>th</sup> at Wallingford Bowl, Wallingford, CT

Board Members Present: President Chris Monroy, 1<sup>st</sup> VP Alex Aguiar, Sec/Treas Becky Kregling, TD Joey Nereu, Dave Forcier, Tim Healey, Mike Lichstein, Ed Roberts & Jack Stehle  
Board Member(s) Absent: 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Rob Hunter, John Ellis & Larry King.

1. Reports of Officers and Tournaments – Reports accepted
2. Discussed Proposed Bylaw Changes
  - a. On Annual Meeting Agenda - Change requirement of a Board Member at Large to apply “in writing to NEBA President by December 31” -to- “must submit in writing his or her interest to the President no later than one week before the annual meeting. At the annual meeting, the President shall appoint members at large with the advice and consent of the board. All Applications shall be retained as official NEBA records.”
  - b. On Annual Meeting Agenda - Add “and 20 days prior to the November tournament” to “Annual Meeting bylaw changes must have been submitted to the Secretary/Treasurer for publication in the November newsletter.”
  - c. On Annual Meeting Agenda - In Requirements for Tournament Sites remove c-Meeting room and g-Bowling center staff support
3. Discuss Proposed Tournament Rules Changes
  - a. Withdrawn by Becky Kregling - Decrease expense fee from \$9 to \$8
  - b. On Annual Meeting Agenda - Increase the entry fee to \$85, change the squad cut from 1:6 -to- 1:5, eliminate the at-large cut, eliminate the senior cut, change the tournament director salary from \$350+\$1 per entry -to- \$3 per entry, change the secretary/treasurer pay from \$350+\$1.50 per entry -to- \$3.50 per entry, change paying the bowling center per game -to- paying the bowling center a fixed amount per entry of \$12, \$13 or \$14, guarantee first place at \$2,500, guarantee the last cash spot at \$150, leave expenses at \$9 (\$3 for TD, \$3 for S/T, \$2 for special tournaments & postage). (2)
  - c. Withdrawn by Alex Aguiar - Increase the minimum to cash ratio from 1 in 5 -to- 1 in 5.25 (see chart below)
  - d. Withdrawn by Becky Kregling - Enforce the “35-mile rule” all squads except the first qualifying squad
4. Discussed Proposed Tournament Rule Changes which did not meet the requirements to be on the annual agenda
  - a. On Annual Meeting Agenda - Change the tournament director salary from \$350+\$1 per entry -to- \$3 per entry, change the secretary/treasurer pay from \$350+\$1.50 per entry -to- \$3.50 per entry and change paying the bowling center per game -to- paying the bowling center a fixed amount per entry of \$12, \$13 or \$14. (2)
5. Annual Meeting Agenda was confirmed with proposals discussed earlier in the meeting along with
  - a. Add: If there is a change in the Tournament Director or an Officer during the middle of the year, the President may appoint the individual leaving the position to the Board of Directors with the approval of the board.
  - b. Run a special tournament or two in 2010 with the proposed tournament changes above.
  - c. Allow doubles teams to defend their title. One time only. The team that won the baker tournament defends their title at the next baker tournament and the team that won the regular format tournament defends their title at the next regular format doubles tournament.
6. It was noted that the “Purpose” of NEBA needs to be rewritten since it states “The purpose of NEBA shall be to unite amateur bowlers...” and NEBA bowlers are not amateurs. Ed Roberts will propose suggestions.
7. It was suggested to run one or two special tournaments next year using the new proposal for format, entry fee & payout.
8. Motion by Alex Aguiar to carryover pins each round in the Point Leaders Invitational. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chris Restock. Passed.
9. Schedule – The schedule committee will confirm the 2010 schedule taking the recommendations of the board into consideration. The board agreed to run the Point Leader Invitational in 2011 but requirements to enter may be altered to include number of tournaments entered as well as points.
10. Sponsors – Cambridge Credit Counseling is back as a sponsor in 2010. Joey Nereu will contact Buddies Pro Shop to see if they will continue their sponsorship. Ebonite’s sponsorship goes through April 30, 2010. Chris Monroy will contact Ebonite about a 2010-11 sponsorship.
11. New Business – Allow doubles partners to defend their title. ~ Treasurer Becky Kregling will work with President Chris Monroy to get the proper names on the bank account.
12. Motion by Chris Restock to adjourn at 11:15. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ed Roberts. Passed.
