## Anthony Pepe Earns Ebonite T of © Title

Anthony Pepe (East Elmhurst, NY) proved he can bowl with the best when he earned the sought after Ebonite Tournament of Champs title. He posted a 1068 (225, 181, 203, 245, 214) on the sport certified shot during qualifying then went up against some of the top player NEBA history. He convincingly defeated 14 time champ Alex Aguiar in the first round, holder of 7 titles RJ Broege and 7-time Bowler of the Year Bill Webb in the semi-finals with 72 pins being the closest match. He took the immediate lead in the final match and never let up to give his opponent a chance to catch him. The final victory over 2-time Bowler of the Year Tony Reynaud ended 483-436. Pepe has gained the respect of his fellow bowlers on and off the lanes during the three years he has bowled in NEBA. The 24 year-old won $\$ 1,250$ plus paid entry to defend his title next year.

Tony Reynaud (Harwinton, CT) started off slow with a 166 then added 197, 247, 203 \& 248 for 1061 and a spot in match play. He also bowled against a tough trio to advance to the championship match. Even though his score would have won most matches, it fell short to Pepe. Reynaud's runnerup finish locked up 2012 Senior Bowler of the Year.

## Borges Becomes First Two-Handed Champ

Darrin Borges (New Bedford, MA) defeated Rai Doblmeier 239-199 in the championship match of the non-champions to become the first twohanded NEBA champ. The righty started off the Saturday event with 260, 290 \& 269 for 819 then added 234 \& 248 to finish with 1301. He averaged 238.6 in match play to win $\$ 2,100$ and a paid entry the next day into the Ebonite Tournament of Champions. The 19 year old has been bowling NEBA for two years. His highest previous finish was fourth in August when he led qualifying at East Providence Lanes.

Rai Doblmeier (Warwick, RI) put together games of $269,214,259,243 \& 246$ to finish second on the last squad with 1231. The 25 year old averaged 240.7 to advance through the bracket to the last round. Doblmeier started the final match off with five of seven strikes to keep the match with 15 pins. An open frame in the eighth opened up the lead for his opponent. Doblmeier won $\$ 1,350$ for second.

1. Reports of Tournament Director and Officers
2. Survey results

6. Create an executive committee consisting of the president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary/treasurer and tournament director. The executive board shall be allowed to handle the business of the organization between meetings and may not create rules for itself. The executive committee is authorized to act for the board in the time in between board meetings and reports to the board.
7. Proposed Tournament Rules Changes
8. Dress Code-Clarify rules. See proposal A and B below.
9. Practice - Change practice before the squad from being limited to the starting lane -to- open practice for the first 12 minutes then the last 3 on the starting lane.
10. Award points at the senior tournaments. These points will be used towards senior bowler of the year points only.
11. Change qualifying from 5 to 4 games at senior tournaments.
12. Decrease the last match play cash spot from a minimum of 1.5 times the entry fee to 1.25 times the entry fee.
13. If the ratio of match play finalists is lowered, change the squad cut ratio from 1 in $6-$ to- 1 in 5 .
14. Change the cash ratio from a minimum of 1 in 5 -to- a minimum of 1 in 4.5 or 1 in 4 . All advance to match play.
15. Change the cash ratio from a minimum of 1 in 5 -to- a minimum of 1 in 4.5 or 1 in 4 . Match play qualifiers are based upon current entry table of qualifiers with a minimum of 1 in 5 . Spots will be paid outside of match play based upon entries. Bowlers are limited to cashing once.
16. A paid entry will be given to the two or four bowlers with the highest scores who did not advance to match play.
17. Lane Conditions - Announce in advance "House shot", "Modified House Shot" or "Sport Shot". If it is a non-house shot, announce the pattern a minimum of 7 days before the tournament with a disclaimer that NEBA isn't responsible if there is an error in putting down the pattern.
18. Lower the entry fee to $\$ 80$.
19. Lower reentries to $\$ 80, \$ 70$ or $\$ 65$.

## Proposal A (Reworded Dress Code Section)

NEBA strives to project a professional image. All participants in a NEBA Tournament are required to observe the following dress code:

1. A shirt with a polo type collar or mock neck collar is required. The participant's name on the back of the shirt in 2 " $4 "$ high letters is required, in a color that contrasts with the shirt's color. Name tags must be horizontally oriented and securely affixed to the back of the shirt. Embroidered names are preferred. The following shirt restrictions apply:
a. Advertising and logos are permissible with the Tournament Director's ultimate discretion.
b. Only previous NEBA champions are permitted to wear a white shirt.
2. Men's pants or shorts of a "business casual" quality are encouraged. Denim pants and shorts are allowed but must present a neat appearance. No gym shorts, balloon pants or sweat pants are allowed.
3. Women's skirts, skorts and shorts must be at least fingertip length when standing with arms down at sides and the garment's outer material must be at least half the distance of the upper leg.
4. No tattered or frayed clothing, clothing with holes, hats, or headbands are allowed.

All decisions regarding attire are at the discretion of the Tournament Director and the decision of the Tournament Director is final. The first infraction of the above rules will generally result in a $\$ 10$ fine, second and subsequent infractions will result in denial of tournament participation. New members and members that have ordered a shirt prior to competition shall be exempt from shirt-related sanctions. New members can compete three times without their name on the back of their shirt.

Proposal B (Reworded Dress Code Section plus rule change which does not allow jeans/denim)
Same as above Proposal except for section 2:
2. Men's pants or shorts of a "business casual" quality are encouraged. Denim pants and shorts are not allowed. No gym shorts, balloon pants or sweat pants are allowed.
