# Everyday is a Holiday for Dale Jr. - Wins Ninth Title 

STEPHEN DALE JR. from Newton, NH won his second title of 2009 and ninth in his career with a final match victory over 7 -time champion Scott Santos. The right-hander is one of only ten people who have won nine or more tournaments in the 46 year history of NEBA. At Holiday Lanes, Dale Jr. finished third on the Saturday night squad with 1217 (257, 257, 197, 279 , and 227) to give him a guaranteed spot in the finals. In match play, he eliminated champion Jesse Cote (Worcester, MA) 217-210, Adam Younger (Acushnet, MA) 242-192, Nick Dean (New Bedford, MA) 187-186 and 7-time champ Tony Reynaud (Harwinton, CT) 257-202 before meeting up with Santos. The duo's high scores disappeared in the championship match. Each missed the pocket once yet, between the two of them, they only threw one triple and two doubles. This kept the match exciting as each bowler slammed the pocket hoping for all ten pins to fall to give them the chance to take control of the match. Dale started with a double for the early lead then fell behind after leaving a pocket 4-9. Santos doubled mid-way through the match to increase his lead to fifteen. Dale finished the match first. He added two crucial strikes to a strike in the eighth to finish with 212. Santos needed a strike in the tenth for the win. Santos missed the pocket for the first time, going a little light, to give Dale Jr. the win. Steve averaged 232.2 for the day with his Ebonite Magic. He won $\$ 1,350$ and moved up to fourth in Bowler of the Year points.

SCOTT SANTOS from Ledyard, CT started the day with a 1082 on the Sunday morning squad. After seeing that would not make the cut, the 45 year old gave it another shot on the last qualifying squad. He put together games of 232, 258, 205, 197 and 233 for 1125 to easily make the squad cut. Santos shot numbers with his Hammer Black Widow en route to the championship match with convincing victories over fellow champions Jon Matunas (Newington, CT) 267-182, Dave Forcier (Coventry, RI) 229-205, Tim Gillick (Milford, CT) 244-139 and Rob Grexer (Douglaston, NY) 247-225. The lefty lost his carry in the final match; leaving corner pins in five of the first nine frames. Even though he was shooting his lowest game in match play, he still got up in the tenth with the opportunity to win. After going light in the tenth, a single pin stood in his way of his eighth title. Santos averaged 238.2 in match play and 226.5 for his fifteen games in Somerset. He earned $\$ 725$ for his runner-up finish and moved into second on the Bowler of the Year points list.

There were 139 entries at the mid-summer tournament in Somerset which advanced thirty-two bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1128. Squad cuts were 1208 on Saturday night (squad leader Chris Jolicouer with 1245), 1169 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Todd Lathrop with 1249) and 1108 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader Tony Reynaud with 1213). There were no byes. The senior cut for two bowlers was higher than the at-large since three seniors made the squad or at-large cuts. Jim Sansone won the extra $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1074. Jim also shot 279 but was not eligible for the high game out of the money prize because he won the senior prize. Out of money prizes are limited to one per person at each tournament. Nate Abdow, Vic Giorgio \& Bill Marios split the $\$ 50$ high game out of the money prize with 279. Todd Lathrop was the tournament high qualifier with 1249 on the Sunday morning squad with games of $246,248,280,217$ and 258 . Ebonite balls were won by Eddie Souza (1118-279 for an Ebonite Lanebreaker) and Dan Gauthier (Raffle for an Ebonite Boom). The field averaged 208.6 in qualifying and 212.9 during match play.
