## Reymaud Owns AMF Girele - Wins for Third Time in East Haven

TONY REYNAUD from Harwinton, CT won his sixth title by throwing strikes at the end of the match to shut out his opponent Jason Baker 237-200. The right-hander won his first NEBA in January 1983 along with his second a few months later. He didn't compete much between his two wins in 1993 and 2004 and is still not a regular but when his schedule allows, the odds are that Tony will make an appearance at NEBA and in the match play finals. This year at Circle, Tony put together games of 246, 257, 212, 266 and 236 for 1217 for fifth on the 81 man Saturday night squad and a guaranteed spot in match play. After being seeded \#14, the forty-seven year-old eliminated champion Chris Hall 207-206, Kevin Williams 248-200, champ Chad Autore 224-200, Stephanie Chiera 279-192 and Vic Giorgio 203-180 to advance to the championship match. He fell behind his opponent early in the final match. Jason threw a four-bagger while Tony suffered a split and open which left him down 27 pins halfway through the match. He responded like a true champion; jumping on an error by his opponent. After an open in the sixth by Jason, Tony started tossing strikes. He threw clutch strikes in the $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ for the opportunity to win the match with a stuffed pocked shot in the $11^{\text {tit }}$. This was Tony's second win in a row in East Haven and third in his career. He won $\$ 2,200$ plus a $\$ 100$ entry into the Tournament of Champions later this year along with a new white champion's shirt.

JASON BAKER from Canajohorie, NY was one match short of winning in only his second career NEBA tournament. The young lefty bowled one event in November then achieved near perfect success in March. In East Haven, he shot 1153 with games of $182,245,222,277$ and 226 which was $48^{\text {th }}$ out of the 294 entries. In match play, he defeated Terry Perrsico 225-175, Mike Repsch 215-199, Mike Kluth 225-204, Adam Paradis 256-150 and Mike Bissmann 269-233. As stated above, Jason led most of the championship match but fell short when his opponent ended with six strikes. He took home $\$ 1,250$ for his runner-up finish. After he was done at NEBA, he headed down to the US Open in NJ where he cashed for $\$ 1,100$ for his $101^{\text {st }}$ place finish.
There were 294 entries, which is the second highest entry we have had since at least the 80 's in the month of March. In 2007 we had 315 entries. The at-large cut for $64^{\text {th }}$ place was 1145 . There were no byes with 64 qualifiers. The senior cut was 1135 . Squad cuts were 1153 on Saturday 6 p.m. (squad leader Chris Rebstock with 1242 - Stoke is back!), 1180 on Sunday 9 a.m. (squad leader Jon Matunas with 1371) and 1124 on Sunday afternoon (squad leader Tim Healey with 1237). The High Qualifier was Jon Matunas who shot an incredible 1371! Jon started followed back-to-back 300 games with 256, 247 and 268 on the Sunday morning squad. Steve Jones shot 300 to win the high game out of the money prize of $\$ 50$. Al Gagliardi won the $\$ 50$ prize for the highest senior who did not make the cut with 1136. Ebonite balls were won by Chris Viale (1143 with 260 high game) and Jayme Silva (Raffle).
