Reynolds Earns Title #2 at Laurel Lanes

Rich Reynolds (East Haddam, CT) won his second title with a narrow 249-246 victory over Chris Carlson at Laurel Lanes. The right-hander shot games of 245, 243, 212, 226 and 227 for 1153 on the Sunday morning squad. His score missed the squad cut by three pins so his score sat on the top of the atlarge list which is where he eventually earned a spot in match play. Reynolds 236 en route the final match. He championship started the match with six strik.es but only held a ten pin lead. It was a two pin match going into the ninth frame. Two seven pins stood in the way of Reynolds throwing a double which gave Carlson the opportunity to double for a his first win. A four pin in the tenth gave the win to Reynolds. He adds this to his first title in January 2005. He won \$1,600 plus a white champion's shirt and a paid \$100 entry into the Ebonite Tournament of Champions in a few weeks

Chris Carlson (Clinton, CT) earned a spot in match play by earning a guaranteed spot in match play after finishing second on the Saturday night squad with 1287 (244, 206, 255, 233, 249). His score was 13th out of the 184 entries which gave him a bye. He advanced through match play with games 215 and up but fell short of winning his first title. Carlson is currently 25th on the points list.



- 1. Reports of Officers & Tournament Director Summaries
- 2. Board Members at Large Appointment for 2012 anyone interested must apply in writing to the President Alex Aguiar by December 10.
- 3. Annual awards prize lists
- Discuss Proposed Bylaw Changes
 (to be acted upon at Annual Meeting unless proposal is withdrawn by person who submitted it):
 - a. Management Add to the list of who comprises the Board of Directors, referred to as the Board, ... Add "h. All past Tournament Directors in good standing (emeritus) and i. All past Secretary/Treasurers in good standing (emeritus)"
 - b. Create an executive committee consisting of the president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary/treasurer and tournament director. The executive board shall be allowed to handle the business of the organization between meetings and may not create rules for itself. The executive committee is authorized to act for the board in the time in between board meetings and reports to the board.
 - c. Board Member At Large Change from "President shall appoint members at large with the advice and consent of the board" to "with advice of the executive committee." Add "appoint members at large which represents the membership"
 - d. Removal of a Board Member Change "Any Board member, who fails to attend three (3) consecutive Board meetings, is subject to removal by a majority vote of a quorum of the Board." To "two (2)"
 - e. Membership Requirements Since there are no PBA tour exemptions in 2012-13, Add an equivalent to "exempt player on the national PBA tour" such as "No national touring I players" or "no players who finished in the top 40 in points on the national PBA in the prior season."
 - f. Annual Meeting To allow the meeting before the annual meeting to be in October or November, change "Any bylaw changes to be voted on must have been submitted in writing to the Secretary/Treasurer by October 15 to for publication in the October NEBA Newsletter" to "September 15 to for publication in the September NEBA Newsletter and posted on the website".

- 5. Discuss Proposed Tournament Rules Changes (to be acted upon at Annual Meeting unless proposal is withdrawn by person who submitted it):
 - a. Dress Code Change from mock necks from bowling companies or NEBA sponsors -to- all mock neck shirts. Allow Capri pants and skirts for women.
 - b. Expenses Decrease expense fee from \$9 to \$8
 - c. Expenses Put \$1 or \$2 per entry aside for the point leader invitational (would change rule of adding a minimum of \$1,000 to money to keep the prize fund at max \$14,000)
 - d. Senior/Women Cuts Move the women from the super senior cut to the regular senior cut.
 - e. Match Play Finals Change "The bowler with the highest qualifying block has a choice of lanes on each pair" to "The highest seeded bowler has a choice..."
 - f. Practice Times evaluate the practice time during qualifying and match play.
 - g. Practice on tournament lanes Allow practice on tournament lanes after the Saturday night squad that have been conditioned with the tournament shot.
 - been conditioned with the tournament shot.

 h. Lane Courtesy Change "Two lane courtesy shall be observed. Bowlers shall make a delivery without an intervening delivery from one of the lanes adjacent to the specific lane." To "one lane courtesy"
 - i. Change the rule of using an alternate to "If a bowler misses roll call, a bye will be given. The bowler who misses roll call will get the last cash spot and points, minus a \$25 fine for not showing up."

- 7. Add a senior cut to the 2012 Tournament of Champions
- 8. Senior of the Year Change eligibility from those who attained 50 by January 1 -to- allow all points earned once the age of 50 has attained.
