## Broege Over Tessier in a Thriller at the Bowl-O-Rama

## RJ BROEGE from West Hartford, CT closed the match at Bowl-o-Rama with clutch shots to snag his third NEBA title.

 The Connecticut native bowled his first NEBA in 1998 then later moved to Vegas. On a visit home in September 2003, he won his first title with a victory over that year's Bowler of the Year Chris Rebstock at Bradley Bowl. Before he came back to New England, RJ added the 2004 Bowlers' Journal singles title in Reno to his resume. Last year was his first full NEBA season and he proved he could compete; finishing fourth in points and sixth in average, winning title two at the trios and making it to the top four in four tournaments. At Bowl-o-Rama, the 27 year old lefty put together games of 203, 237, 259, 215 and 257 for 1171 on the Saturday night squad. That score advanced him to match play off the at-large list. In the first round, he shot 235 to get by top 2 of 3 round against Mike Prinitz's 266 and 202 by Steve Blanchet then he defeated Mike Kluth (North Haven, CT) 214206, Mike Prinitz (Wakefield, RI) 228-212, Rich Reynolds (East Haddam, CT) 233-200 and Bobby Fleetwood (Naugatuck, CT) 242-183. The upcoming championship was one of the most exciting this year. RJ and William were tied to the pin after tossing five shots in the pocket each. Each missed the pocket in the sixth. RJ had a chance to take the lead in the eighth but he went light, again, on the right lane resulting in a bucket. William got up and threw a double to take a nine pin lead going into the tenth. RJ struck in the ninth then made clutch shots in the tenth on the lane which had given him so much trouble. By striking out, he forced William to throw a double. William got the first one then left a stone nine to narrowly lose the match. With a win and a second place finish, RJ is definitely a threat in this year's bowler of the year race.$$

WILLIAM TESSIER from Woonsocket, RI continued his great bowling with his third championship appearance in the last six months. The 21 year-old grabbed his first win at the non-champions' last December. In February, William made it to the championship round at the True Amateur Tournament in Vegas and in March he advanced to the NEBA championship match. This month in Newington, William earned a guaranteed spot in match play with games of 259, 253, 233, 234 and 234 for 1213 on the Sunday morning squad. His score was $7^{\text {th }}$ on the 67 person squad and $9^{\text {th }}$ out of the 189 entries, which gave him a one round bye. In his fifth straight match play appearance, he averaged 223.6 against Bill Webb (Enfield, CT) 191-187, Steve Fiume (East Hartford, CT) 249-147, Joe Talarczyk (Guilford, CT) 230-213 and Frankie Calca (Elmont, NY) 213-201 in the semi-finals. As stated above, William bowled a great final match but was a shot short of winning his first title.
There were 189 entries at Newington's Bowl-o-Rama which advanced forty bowlers into match play. The at-large cut was 1164. Squad cuts were 1180 on Saturday night (squad leader Rob LaFountain with 1248), 1188 at 9 a.m. (squad leader Dan Malkin with 1307) and 1120 at 12:30 p.m. (squad leader Pete Bostick with 1244). The score needed for a one round bye was 1194 ( $16^{\text {th }}$ place). The senior cut was 1162 . John Martino won the extra $\$ 50$ senior prize with 1111. Dan Malkin was the tournament high qualifier with 1307 on the Sunday morning squad with games of 278, 257, 247, 257 and 268. Erik DeVito, Mark Neri and Jim Strong split the high game out of the money prize with 300 games. Ebonite Complete NVs were won by Ryan Devlin (1161) and Tony Reynaud (Raffle). The field average in qualifying was 212.1 and 215.6 in match play.
